WHAT IS SOLO ACTS?

A THEATRE INSPIRED PROJECT THAT STRIVES TO RAISE AWARENESS, CHALLENGE PREVAILING IDEAS, ADVOCATE AND AFFIRM THE COMPLEX REALITIES OF THOSE THAT AGE SOLO. SOLO ACTS WAS BASED ON INTERVIEWS AND CONVERSATIONS WITH SOLO AGERS IN NEW YORK AND MICHIGAN.

WHO ARE SOLO AGERS?

FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS PROJECT, WE PRIMARILY DEFINED SOLO AGERS AS ANYONE AGED 65 OR ABOVE WHO IS LIVING ALONE WITH NO PAID CAREGIVING ASSISTANCE, AND MINIMAL FAMILY/CAREGIVER SUPPORT LIVING WITHIN A FIVE HOUR DRIVE. HOWEVER, SINCE THE INITIAL WORK OUR DEFINITION HAS EXPANDED TO INCLUDE THOSE AGING YOUNGER THAN 65 AND THOSE CARING FOR THOSE WITH MEMORY LOSS.
